## **Olney's Value Today**

Dear Friends,

I have struggled to find the words for this section of the annual report. Standard language exists for these kinds of letters, but it would not have worked for our purposes. Instead, I patiently waited for the words to come.

During a recent visit to Robben Island in South Africa, I was overtaken by an overwhelming sense of gratitude for Olney. For more than 185 years, our school has modeled tolerance, nonviolence, and equality. It has inspired students to engage in social justice programs beyond performative activism. On Robben Island, where a repressive regime imprisoned political activists (e.g., Nelson Mandela, Govan Mbeki, and Walter Sisulu), I heard stories that showcased the best and worst of humanity. The prisoners formed a strong community despite the incredible suffering they endured. With a bleak future

ahead of them, they found meaning in the things they could do together. They found hope in the moments they could speak with and help each other.

We can easily forget the value of what we do at Olney, but such stories bring our mission into sharp focus. The simple things we do together daily teach us tolerance and how to live with people who do not look like us. The tough times we go through as a community build bonds of trust that transcend generations, cultures, and socio-economic boundaries. Our worship and approach to community decision-making allow us always to put the good of the community above individual needs.

We intentionally set out to model what it means to temper ego and open up to the richness of our diversity. In that way, we become more aware of other souls, reflect on our impact on others, give others a chance to shine, uplift the dignity in others, and leave a better world for the next generations. That inexhaustive list of what we do represents part of what Nelson Mandela and his colleagues wanted to see in South Africa. It continues to express what we should do to make this world more peaceful, safe, and rewarding, even when some powers want to make us fear and dominate each other.

Thank you for making it possible for us to continue making Olney's mission a reality. I invite you to continue supporting us as we do our part to inspire our future leaders.

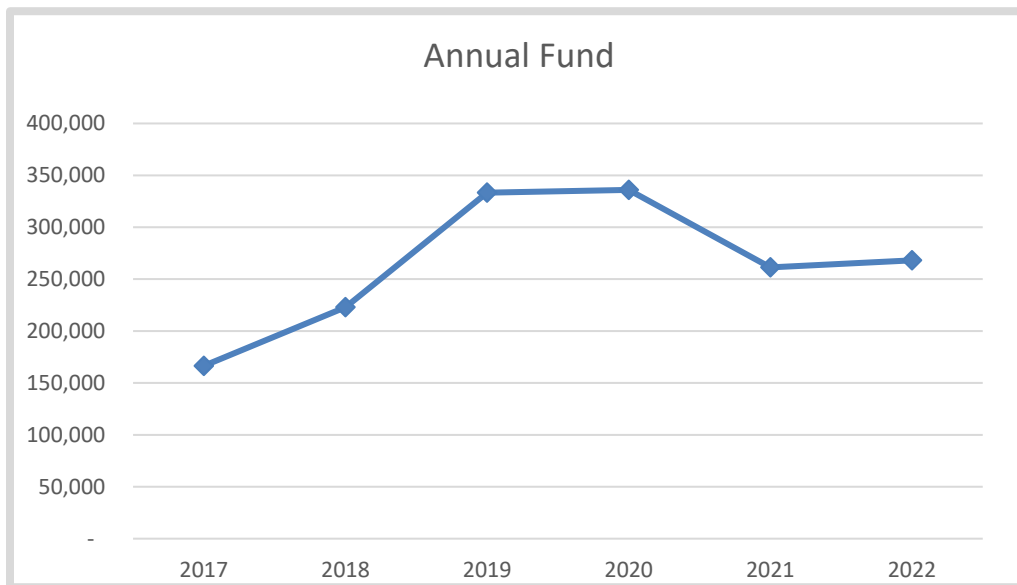


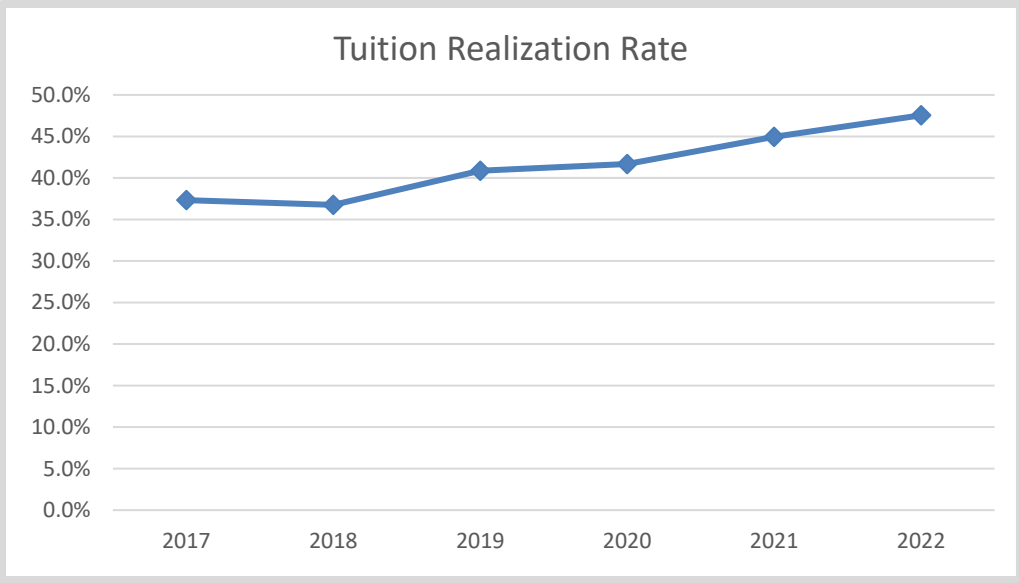
#### 2021-2022 Revenue
